**\*EXPLANATION OF ZONE DESIGNATIONS**

ZONE	EXPLANATION
A	Areas of 100-year flood; base flood elevations and flood hazard factors not determined.
A0	Areas of 100-year shallow flooding where depths are between one (1) and three (3) feet; average depths of inundation are shown, but no flood hazard factors are determined.
AH	Areas of 100-year shallow flooding where depths are between one (1) and three (3) feet; base flood elevations are shown, but no flood hazard factors are determined.
A1-A30	Areas of 100-year flood; base flood elevations and flood hazard factors determined.
A99	Areas of 100-year flood to be protected by flood protection system under construction; base flood elevations and flood hazard factors not determined.
B	Areas between limits of the 100-year flood and 500-year flood; or certain areas subject to 100-year flooding with average depths less than one (1) foot or where the contributing drainage area is less than one square mile; or areas protected by levees from the base flood. (Medium shading)
C	Areas of minimal flooding. (No shading)
D	Areas of undetermined, but possible, flood hazards.
V	Areas of 100-year coastal flood with velocity (wave action); base flood elevations and flood hazard factors not determined.
V1-V30	Areas of 100-year coastal flood with velocity (wave action); base flood elevations and flood hazard factors determined.

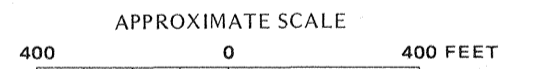
Certain areas not in the special flood hazard areas (zones A and V) may be protected by flood control structures.

REFERENCE MARK	ELEVATION (FT. NGVD)	DESCRIPTION OF LOCATION
RM1*	5084.120	A standard monel-metal rivet in the top of the south end of the back wall of the east abutment of what was Chicago and North Western Railway bridge No. 1535 over the Popo Agie River. This abutment stands, approximately 1500 feet west of the southwest bend of Main Street at the north edge of Hudson. Established by U.S. Coast and Geodetic Survey.
RM2	5077.64	Top of operating nut, on fire hydrant on the west side of State Highway 789 at Bridge Street. Established by Nelson, Haley, Patterson & Quirk, Inc.
RM3*	5080.53	Top of gate post, west side of field approach, north side of State Highway 789 in right-of-way fence. Established by Nelson, Haley, Patterson & Quirk, Inc.
RM4*	5073.75	Top of corner post in right-of-way fence, 55 feet north of the center line of State Highway 789. Established by Nelson, Haley, Patterson, & Quirk, Inc.
RM5	5079.73	Top of northeast anchor bolt for Texaco sign, north end of gas pump island in front of Texaco station, west side of Main Street. Established by Nelson, Haley, Patterson & Quirk, Inc.
RM6	5085.20	Top of operating nut, on fire hydrant at the southeast corner of intersection of First and Main Streets. Established by Nelson, Haley, Patterson & Quirk, Inc.
RM7	5088.19	Top of operating nut, on fire hydrant at the northwest corner of intersection of Second and Main Streets. Established by Nelson, Haley, Patterson & Quirk, Inc.
RM8	5090.99	Top of operating nut, on fire hydrant at the southeast corner of intersection of Third and Main Streets. Established by Nelson, Haley, Patterson & Quirk, Inc.
RM9*	5088.71	Top of southeast corner of the southeast wingwall of the State Highway 789 bridge over the Little Popo Agie River. Established by Nelson, Haley, Patterson & Quirk, Inc.
RM10	5085.75	Nail in power pole No. Y-61 JUN 107 WCP, on west side of Oklahoma Avenue, 200 feet south at intersection with Sixth Street. Established by Nelson, Haley, Patterson & Quirk, Inc.
RM11	5087.43	Nail in power and light pole at the intersection of Eighth Street and Oklahoma Avenue. Established by Nelson, Haley, Patterson & Quirk, Inc.
